### **Father God,**

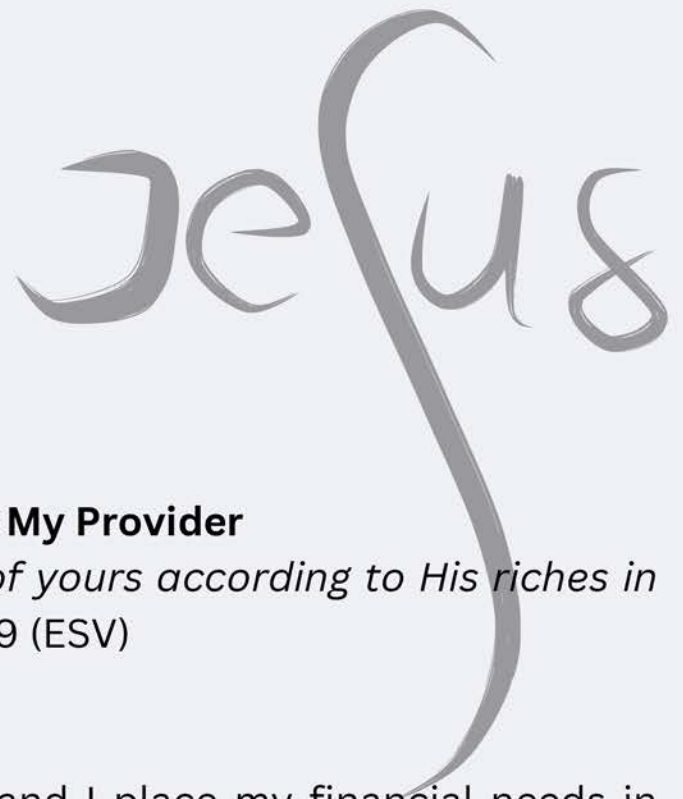
